I will come back later."




He secretly made little signs with pictures of Fly Guy.



He put signs up around his neighborhood.



A fly flew up to Buzz. "Who are you?" said Buzz.





After Fly Guy hugged his whole family, Buzz said, "It really is time for dinner. Everyone follow me!"






Mom and Dad were surprised. "What are we going to do with all these flies?" cried Dad.

# Buzz opened the window. "TIME TO PARTY!"







Outside, a truck dumped garbage in the yard and drove away.

Fly Guy and his family flew outside.





